3. Complete the fields in the Summary window above. The Turnitin Assignment Name and Submission Type fields are mandatory. To see information about a field, click the ? icon.
4. In addition to the Name and whether students will submit a file or text in the Submission Type field, you can specify the maximum file size, and how to display grades, either as a fraction or as a percentage.
5. If you set the Display Similarity Reports to Students field to Yes, students will be able to see their Turnitin similarity score. If you want the students to see their similarity score, you must set this field to Yes.
6. Click the down arrow next to **Similarity Report Options** to see the settings available. These include whether you will accept submissions after the due date, when the Turnitin report is generated, and the options that you want Turnitin to check for the students' work.
